

APPLICATION FOR LIQUOR LICENSE

REQUIRED BY: Village of Richton Park Code of Ordinances

FIRST TIME APPLICANTS ONLY:

All first time applications must be accompanied by \$100.00 application fee per the Richton Park Municipal Code, Chapter 3, Section 20, 20-c. If the fee is not received, the application will not be considered. The fee is non-refundable and will not be applied toward the liquor license fee.

ALL LIQUOR LICENSE APPLICANTS:

Circle class of liquor license applied for. The liquor license fee shall be as follows:

Class	Fee	Type
A	\$1,500	Authorizes the retail sale of alcoholic liquor on the premises for consumption. Except for beer and wine served in the original package, all alcoholic beverages must be served by the glass only.
B	\$1,200	Authorizes the retail sale of beer and wine for consumption on the premises where sold.
C	\$1,000	Authorizes the retail sale of alcoholic liquor, but not for consumption on the premises where sold. All alcoholic liquor must be sold from the licensed premises and no off-premises sale or delivery is allowed.
D	\$800	Authorizes the retail sale of wine, beer, wine coolers and hard lemonade, but no other hard liquor and/or spirits. Does not permit the consumption of alcohol on the premises where sold. It must be sold from the licensed premises and no off-premises sale or delivery is allowed.
E	\$200	Authorizes the sale of alcoholic liquor on premises owned by or under long-term lease to the local posts of national veterans' organizations that are exempt from federal income taxation, and whose membership consists exclusively of veterans of the military and naval services of the United States of America, for consumption on the specified premises only by members and their guests, or for consumption at periodic private events held on the premises.
F	\$1,250	Authorizes the retail sale of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises of a restaurant; provided, however, that the service of alcoholic liquor shall only be from a service bar to tables and shall only be during times when the kitchen is open and meals are available to be ordered and served to the public.
G	\$1,000	A BYOB license shall authorize the consumption of beer, wine and liquor which has been brought onto the premises of a retail tobacco store operating as a public accommodate by a patron or patrons as a complement to the sale, purchase and consumption of tobacco products in said retail tobacco store. The consumption of alcoholic beverages pursuant to a Public Accommodation BYOB license is subject to compliance with the following regulations (see Village of Richton Park Ordinance No. 1551 for the regulations).
Temporary	\$200 per day	Authorizes the retail sale on the premises specified of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises where sold, which permit shall be void 24 hours after issuance, and may be issued to any person eligible and in compliance with Section 806.05 and upon approval by the Local Liquor Control Commissioner. The permit shall be granted subject to all provisions of this chapter, specifically those pertaining to the hours of operation in Section 806.24. An application fee shall be required for such temporary permit, but may be waived by the Village Board if recommended by the Village Staff.

The liquor license fee will be due and payable only after the Liquor Commissioner has approved issuance of the liquor license. However, the liquor license will be issued only after receipt of the appropriate liquor license fee.

Evidence of Insurability or Certificate of Insurance is also required prior to the completion of the liquor license process.
