Enclosed is the 2020 Liquor Commissioner's Annual report, filed in accordance with Chapter 806.29 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Richton Park. This report summarizes the liquor licensing events, incidents reported and other information concerning the liquor license establishments in our community.

During this past reporting year, we had **12** liquor licenses issued and **one** reported police involved incident. Also, **one** liquor incident was reported from a business that did not have a liquor license.

We, as a Village, will continue to be diligent in our efforts to ensure that license holders act responsibly and in the best interest of the citizens of the Village of Richton Park.

Report Summary

Licenses - During **2020** there were **11** liquor licenses issued to existing businesses and **one** liquor license issued to a new business. A listing of licenses by classification and fees paid is found attached to this report.

A total of **\$13,450** was collected in licensing fees for the various classifications established by ordinance.

Incidents - During **2020** there was **one** incident requiring police intervention or action to the **12** liquor license businesses.

On November 19, 2020, police were dispatched to Eduardo Leamon Cigars in which a complainant and suspect had a disagreement on a wage placed a few weeks ago. The complainant pushed the suspect into the wall and breaking his glasses. A witness from the establishment stated that the complainant approached the suspect aggressively and a "tussle" took place in the doorway. Based on conflicting statements provided by parties on the scene, no arrests were made. No liquor violations were observed in regard to this incident.

On September 18, 2020, officers were doing a premise check at Ven'You, where an event was taking place. Guests were permitted to consume liquor on the premise without them having an approved liquor license. Since this is a liquor violation, the officer wrote a liquor incident report and the supervisor recommended a hearing take place. The Chief of Police also concurred with this recommendation.
